I hereby release CISV and its volunteers from any financial or legal cause of action arising through sickness or accident, except by reason of gross negligence by CISV and/or its volunteers during the CISV programme. In the event of any legal / insurance claim against CISV International Ltd, I / we agree to have the claim settled under the laws of Great Britain.

A CISV participant is expected to conduct her / himself at all times (Both during travel and the CISV programme) in conformance with local laws and CISV rules. Participants engaging in inappropriate behaviour may be sent home before the end of the programme at CISV's discretion and without CISV financial liability (see programme *Guides* for procedure / guidance).

I have been informed about the CISV insurance rule and understand that it is my responsibility to provide adequate health and accident insurance for my child both during travel and the CISV programme. I also understand that all travel arrangements to and from the CISV programme and appropriate baggage / flight cancellation insurance are our own responsibility consistent with CISV National / Chapter rules and / or guidelines issued by CISV International Ltd.
